- Extended Writing
- Oral Language
- Oral Reading

Some Cognitive Processing Skills that are used during Basic Language Skills are:

- *Working Memory
- *Visual & Auditory Processing
- *Long Term Memory
- *Comprehension Knowledge
- *Fluid Reasoning

Recommended schedule: (as determined by Neuhaus Education Center)

4-5 days a week, 50-60 minute sessions for 2-3 years
